

Ten tenners in ten month – can we raise £10k?

As part of the school's ten-year celebration pupils have given the ambitious target of raising £10 000 in aid of Tŷ Hafan.



One of the initiatives has been to ask each pupil to *try* to raise a tenner a month for ten months. If everyone could manage to do this the school will have surpassed its target with this one activity alone.

Each child has been given a card so they can track their progress and show people they have approached what they are doing and why.



Shelley Kirkham, from Tŷ Hafan, visited the school to speak to pupils during an assembly and explained a little more about what the charity does in supporting children with life limiting illnesses. They also help their families who need support too as their lives are affected as well. She was thrilled to learn that the school had already raised over £300 at its recent car rally and was amazed to hear of their ambitious target for the year ahead.
